 - The 2 electronic copies (flash drive) should be placed in a smaller envelope and properly affixed to the original paper submission.
5. Bids will be opened in the presence of those bidders or their representatives who choose to attend at 09:00 hours on **21st February, 2023** in the boardroom of the National Procurement and Tender Administration Board, Ministry of Finance at the above address.
 6. All bids must be accompanied by valid certificates of compliance from the Manager of the National Insurance Scheme and the Commissioner of the Guyana Revenue Authority.
 7. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security amounting to the value specified in the bid document.
 8. The National Procurement and Tender Administration, Ministry of Finance reserves the right to reject any or all bids without assigning any reason whatsoever and not necessarily to award to the lowest bid.
